

## Certificate in Community Boat Management . Student Guide

### Welcomeõ .

This two-day course is designed to assess the skills and experience you have in handling a boat and managing the safety and welfare of passengers on our inland waterways.

If you feel you do not have this level of experience, then many community boat projects are able to arrange training days to help you gain experience.

The topics that will be assessed include Craft Knowledge, Practical Boat-handling, Group Management and Group Safety issues.

Assessment will be by observation of tasks and activities, through discussion and by oral questioning.

There will a maximum of five students on the course at any time.

All courses include at least one overnight stay on the boat. Participants usually find this an ideal opportunity to share experiences and review the day's activities.
